

Student is intoxicated

Before any conclusions are drawn, consider if the student's impairment is being caused by a medical condition or an injury.

If a student appears to be impaired in some way it is important to ensure the safety of the student in question, as well as other students and staff.

Prioritise safety

Is this an emergency situation?

no

Monitor for further risk

Ensure student is taken to a safe place to recover (e.g. school sickbay). Closely monitor the student until fully recovered and take appropriate steps if condition worsens. Notify senior school staff of incident and follow school procedure.

yes

CALL AMBULANCE

Follow basic first-aid while waiting for an ambulance. Do not leave student unattended.

Manage the situation as an emergency if the student is injured, unconscious, or in danger of losing consciousness, having a seizure and/or having difficulty standing, breathing or talking, or presenting with any other concerning symptoms.
